TCP's trustees would like to advise all current members and users of the swimming pool, gym and studio facility at Palmers Meadow that once Halo takes over operational management of the facility, from April 2025, all services and classes offered by the incumbent operator at the point of its exit will be maintained. For example, a swim only membership will continue to be in place and all swim school classes will remain.
